

EQUESTRIAN WEEKEND EXTRAVAGANZA - *Everything* you need to know for the RIDE...

PARKING FEES - IF you reserved a campsite that is FREE, you will need to pay the overnight camping fee of \$8/night to the Forest Service. IF you are a day-only rider, you will need to pay the day-use \$3/day fee to the Forest Service. Please pick up an envelope at the campground entrance. IF you have reserved a PAID campsite, the Forest Service payment is included, and no separate payment is needed. We will write one check to the Forest Service to cover those sites.

REGISTRATION – Registration check-in is at the far end group picnic area of the campground. Every rider must check-in to get your weekend packet including your ride wristband and meal tickets. Registration will begin on Friday at 3 p.m. until dark, again Saturday morning from 7-8 a.m., and Sunday 7-9 a.m. (PLEASE, do not bring horses up to the check-in table)

Riders under 18 are required to wear a helmet.

Saturday Trail Rides –

ALL riders must CHECK-OUT (at the signboards where you turned into the campground) as you leave on your ride and then CHECK BACK-IN on your return (same place). Even if you re-ride the 5 miler or add the 5-miler onto your 12-miles, you must check-out and back-in. There will be people there at 8 a.m. to take your name and check your ride wristband and will be waiting for you to return so we know everyone that went out came back. We don't want to lose anyone!!

- 20-milers have to be out on the trail between 8 and 9 a.m.
- 12-milers have to be out on the trail between 8 and 10 a.m. Please understand we have to enforce these times so our sweep riders have enough time to get back for dinner with us! If you are late, we will direct you to a shorter trail. You cannot be behind the sweep riders 😊
- 5-milers may ride the trail at their convenience and more than once as long as you are back to camp by 4:00. There are no sweep riders on the 5-mile loop. Make sure you sign out and back in each time.

BBQ begins approximately 4:00. Everyone eating needs a dinner ticket (meal ticket #1). Bring a chair. Raffle winners will be drawn during dinner - You must be present to take home your prize. Group campfire and entertainment to follow.

Sunday Poker Ride – Join us between 8 and 9 a.m. for coffee, tea, and an eggs, pancakes, and sausage breakfast (meal ticket #2). Then, saddle up your horses, grab your game card(s) from your ride packet, and head out on the 5-mile Enchanted Forest trail to collect your winning points. Everyone meanders out anytime between 10 and 11 a.m., making several stops along the way to play games and collect your points. Our team will determine the winners while we enjoy a yummy Mexican lunch (meal ticket #3) between 1 and 2 p.m. You must be present to take home your prize.

T-SHIRTS & MEMBERSHIP - T-Shirts and other GDETF clothing will be available to purchase as well as membership information and forms. 2020 Membership is \$30/person and \$45/couple and runs through March 2021.

YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR YOUR HORSE. WE DO NOT HAVE A VET ON THE GROUNDS. Local vet phone numbers are available at the check-in desk. Please, ride within the limits of what your horse can do.

LEAVE YOUR CAMPGROUND AREA CLEAN - spread manure 'n hay. Dog must be on leash at all times. Thanks for helping us keep everyone safe.
