

EQUESTRIAN FUN RIDE WEEKEND - *Everything* you need to know for the RIDE...

PARKING FEES - IF you are a day-only rider, you will need to pay the day-use \$3/day fee to the Forest Service. Please pick up an envelope at the campground entrance. IF you have reserved a PAID campsite, the Forest Service payment is included, and no separate payment is needed. We will write one check to the Forest Service to cover those sites.

REGISTRATION – Registration check-in is at the far end group picnic area of the campground. Every rider must check-in to get your weekend packet including your ride wristband and meal tickets. Registration will begin on Friday at 3 p.m. until dark, again Saturday morning from 7-9 a.m., and Sunday 7-9 a.m. (PLEASE, do not bring horses up to the check-in table)

Riders under 18 are required to wear a helmet.

Saturday Trail Rides –

ALL riders must CHECK-OUT (at the signboards where you turned into the campground) as you leave on your ride and then CHECK BACK-IN on your return (same place). Even if you re-ride the 5 miler or add the 5-miler onto your 12-miles, you must check-out and back-in. There will be people there at 8 a.m. to take your name and check your ride wristband and will be waiting for you to return so we know everyone that went out came back. We don't want to lose anyone!!

- 20-milers have to be out on the trail between 8 and 9 a.m.
- 12-milers have to be out on the trail between 8 and 10 a.m. Please understand we have to enforce these times so our sweep riders have enough time to get back for dinner with us! If you are late, we will direct you to a shorter trail. You cannot ride behind the sweep riders. 😊
- 5-milers may ride the trail at their convenience and more than once as long as you are back to camp by 4:00 p.m. There are no sweep riders on the 5-mile loop. Make sure you sign out and back in each time.

The Barmhaus Brewery BBQ begins approximately 4:00 p.m. Everyone eating needs a dinner ticket (meal ticket #1). Bring a chair. Raffle winners will be drawn during dinner - You must be present to take home your prize. Group campfire and entertainment to follow.

Sunday Enchanted Forest Breakfast/Obstacle Course/Potluck – Join us between 8 and 9 a.m. for coffee, tea, juice and “world famous” breakfast burritos care of the Native Sons of the Golden West, Georgetown chapter (meal ticket #2). Then, saddle up your horses and head out on the marked, 5-mile Enchanted Forest trail and/or the optional trail obstacle course where you can try challenges for a chance to win a prize. Please plan on packing your own lunch. Join us at 4 p.m. for the GDETF Potluck and obstacle results. (GDETF will provide the main course. Meal ticket #3.) If your last name begins in A – D, please bring an appetizer, E – J, please bring a salad, K - P, please bring a side dish and Q - Z, please bring a dessert.

T-SHIRTS & MEMBERSHIP - T-Shirts and other GDETF clothing will be available for purchase as well as membership information and forms. Membership is \$35/person and \$50/family.

YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR YOUR HORSE. WE DO NOT HAVE A VET ON THE GROUNDS. Local vet phone numbers are available at the check-in desk. Please, ride within the limits of what your horse can do.

LEAVE YOUR CAMPGROUND AREA CLEAN – due to staffing cuts trash will need to be disposed of in the large dumpsters around the campground. Manure must be scattered in the woods surrounding your campsite. Dogs must be on leash at all times. Thanks for helping us keep everyone safe.
